The greens and fairways consist of bentgrass/poa. All 82 bunkers were renovated by Raymond Hearn in 2022 and now feature Pro / Angle Sand for increased playability and easier maintenance. The tee-boxes were lengthened for added yardage as well as new sightlines and shot-making options. The greens and grounds department employs approximately 20 people during peak season. Our goal in the golf course maintenance department is to focus on life/work balance and to grow our assistants to become superintendents in the future.
